

TAILGATING RULES



ONE PERMIT = ONE SPACE FOR ONE VEHICLE

- Fans may not occupy parking spaces with tailgate equipment like grills, tables, etc.
- Tailgaters should back their vehicles into the exterior/ perimeter parking spaces and tailgate in the landscaped areas, not in the unoccupied parking spaces next to you.
- Drive aisles and file lanes need to be kept clear at all times to allow emergency vehicles unobstructed access.
- Barbecue grills are allowed; however, their use in areas where guests or property may be damaged is strictly prohibited.
- All tailgate parties must conclude 60 minutes prior to kickoff. Tents, tables, chairs, etc. must be broken down prior to entering the stadium.
- Parking spaces are first-come, first-served. Fans may not block or save spaces. Vehicles may be directed to exterior parking spaces in designated tailgate areas within the parking lots upon arrival.

NOT ALLOWED

- Saving or blocking parking spaces, drive lanes, pedestrian aisle ways, sidewalks or disabled access aisles.
- Kegs, glass bottles, open flame fires or weapons of any kind.
- Open flame fires of any kind or the use of grills in areas where guests or property may be damaged.
- Commercial activity of any kind (including, but not limited to advertising, promotion, solicitation, etc. without advance written approval by the Denver Broncos).
- Any unacceptable behaviors listed in the Fan Code of Conduct.

FAN CODE OF CONDUCT





Empower Field at Mile high and the Denver Broncos are committed to creating a safe, comfortable and enjoyable experience for all fans, both in the stadium and in the parking lot. Therefore, a Fan Code of Conduct exists for all guests.

To anonymously report unruly fan behavior, parking issues, possible security concerns or any other type of problem which may be present in the stadium environment, you can use your cell phone to text 720-650-6464 or call the Fan Behavior Hotline at 720-258-3850.

Please provide specific information including a description & location of the situation, along with any other information that might be necessary. Stadium staff will be dispatched immediately to respond.

The following behaviors will not be tolerated at Empower Field at Mile High.

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive, threatening or illegal in nature.
- Intoxication or other signs of alcohol or substance impairment that results in irresponsible behavior.
- Interfering with the progress of the game, including throwing objects onto the field or in the stadium premises.
- Failing to follow instructions of law enforcement, guest services, and security personnel.
- Verbal or physical harassment of all fans.
- Unreasonably obstructing the view of other patrons.
- Offensive language, obscene gestures, language or clothing, to include the use of such language or gestures concerning a person's race, ethnicity, color, gender, religion, creed, disability, age, sexual orientation, gender identity/expression or national origin; or to instigate, incite or encourage a confrontation or physical assault.
- Any conduct deemed inappropriate or dangerous to fans, participants, officials or stadium staff.
- Conduct that results in damage to the stadium or other personal property.
- · Smoking, except in designated areas.

We value your enthusiasm but ask that all fans exercise good judgment and observe the Code of Conduct listed above. Please respect the rights of others by displaying proper decorum. Season ticket holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of persons occupying their seats.

If a fan violates the Fan Code of Conduct and fails to identify themselves to stadium staff, the fan is subject to penalty, including being barred from the stadium and subject to a league-wide ban. The ticket holder of record may be subject to disciplinary measures including ticket suspension.

Prior to entering stadium gates, all patrons will be subject to security screening, including metal detector screening and inspection of bags or other items carried in. Please refer to empowerfieldatmilehigh.com for the most detailed information.
